CRS Mini Girls A Team bagged Gold in Ernakulam District Throwball Championship held at Delta School, Fort Kochi on Sept, 10.



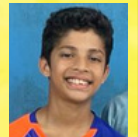
CRS Mini Girls B Team bagged Bronze in Ernakulam District Throwball Championship held at Delta School, Fort Kochi on Sept, 10.

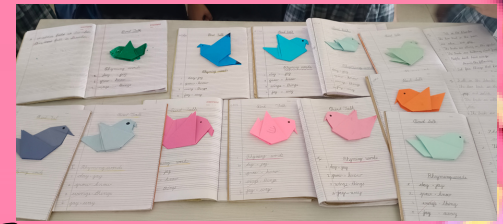
